## Job Description Position: DPW Laborer

### Summary

Assist in installation, maintaining, and / or repair of City sewer lines, water lines, streets, sidewalks, parks, buildings, trees, traffic signs and clean sewers. Perform related work as required by the City Superintendent or his / her delegate.

### Supervision Received

The City Superintendent provides daily assignments and supervision.

### Responsibilities and Duties

An employee in this position may be called upon to do any or all of the following essential duties: (These examples do not include all of the duties which the employee may be expected to perform.)

1. Install, maintain, and / or repair City sewer lines, water lines, streets, sidewalks, parks, buildings, trees, traffic signs, and clean sewers.
  - a. Make excavation cuts and patch curbs, sidewalks and pavements. Erect and repair street and traffic signs. Remove ice and snow from streets, along with salt streets.
  - b. Clean storm and sanitary sewers; install new sewer lines / drain fields.
  - c. Install and repair water lines; locate and mark water lines.
  - d. Sweep streets and empty trash barrels in parks and downtown area.
  - e. Mow grass and trim trees on City maintained properties. Paint buildings and refinish picnic tables; maintain parks / athletic facilities.
2. Operate and maintain variety of heavy and light motor vehicles and mechanical equipment.

- a. Operate light and heavy motor vehicles to haul materials and equipment to work sites, and to plow snow and spread salt on streets.
  - b. Operate tractor, front-end loader, backhoe, street sweeper, road grader and specialized equipment such as sewer vacuum, earth bore machine, ropes and saddle (for tree trimming), and air compressors.
  - c. Operate a variety of power tools such as mowers, chain saws, air hammers, and sprayers.
  - d. Assist in the maintenance and light repair of mechanical equipment. Wash, clean, fuel, lubricate and change oil in vehicles. Change and repair tires.
3. Perform related work as required.

#### Employment Qualifications

An employee in this class, upon appointment, should have the equivalent of the following knowledge, training and experience:

- a. Knowledge of the procedures / practices for operating and maintaining assigned vehicles and mechanical equipment.
- b. Knowledge of safety procedures / precautions involved in various public works projects and equipment operations.
- c. Skill in operation of assigned vehicles / mechanical equipment/power tools.
- d. Skill in establishing / maintaining effective working relationships with fellow employees.

Required training includes a high school diploma or equivalent. A motor vehicle operator's license is required.
