ORDINANCE NO.

Amendment to Chapter 3 of the City Code

An ordinance to amend Chapter 3 of the City Code of the City of Morenci to regarding public consumption of alcohol.

CITY OF MORENCI, LENAWE COUNTY, MICHIGAN, HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Repeal.

Section 3-2 of Chapter 3 of the City of Morenci municipal code is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Amendment.

Section 3-8 of Chapter 3 of the City of Morenci municipal code is amended to the following:

Sec. 3-8. - Consumption or possession on public property.

No person shall possess or consume alcoholic liquor in any public park, public place of amusement, or publicly owned area that is owned or administered, or both, by the city, such possession and/or consumption may be allowed upon application of the representative or representatives of a specific organized event for a portion of Wakefield Park to be designated by city council upon approval of such application and such designated area of Wakefield Park shall be clearly marked by the city police department. Approval of such application shall be only for a specific event and shall designate the dates and times during which such approval shall be effective. Additionally, such possession and/or consumption may be allowed by a venue using a public park, public place of amusement, or publicly owned area if licensed under the City of Morenci's Sidewalk / Outdoor Café Ordinance in Chapter 22 of the City of Morenci municipal code.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions.

All other City ordinances, City Council resolutions, and parts thereof that conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and shall be of no further force or effect.

Section 4. Severability.

All sections, terms, provisions or clauses of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent and severable. Should a court of competent jurisdiction hold any section, term, provision or clause void or invalid, all remaining sections, terms, provisions and clauses not held void or invalid shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Publication and Effective Date.

Publication of this ordinance shall be made by causing a true copy thereof to be inserted once in the State Line Observer, a newspaper circulating within the City of Morenci. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after the ordinance is published.
