



Rules & Information

Evening Wear

Outfits can be custom made or off the rack. Anything from homecoming/prom dresses, Easter dresses, or even glitz pageant dresses are acceptable.

Judging

Our judges will be judging on personality, stage presence, self-confidence, first impression and overall appearance for Formal Wear. For the Queen and Princess awards the judges do not judge on facial beauty. We believe every contestant is beautiful and we want to see the girls just have fun. Judges all have opinions and you are being judged on their opinion your score will be a combination of their opinions. There will be out-of-town judges. Judges' scores are final and undisputable. Our judges are unbiased and have no relation to or preference for any of the contestants. Each and every contestant is judged on the same criteria and none will be given unfair advantage.

That being said, each and every contestant is eligible to be crowned queen as it would be unfair to allow someone to participate knowing that they wouldn't be able to win. This includes the children of festival committee members. No one on the festival committee will have ANY say in scoring, nor will they be able to speak to the judges during scoring. If the child of a committee member is crowned queen, it would be based solely on judges' scores.

Hair / Make-up

Please don't feel pressure to put makeup on your child. Our judges have criteria for scoring that does not include makeup so a full face of makeup will not help their score and is not necessary. It is ultimately up to parental discretion. You won't be penalized for makeup but it also won't boost your score.

For all ages, we ask that contestants do not have hairpieces (fake hair), spray tans or flippers (false teeth generally worn for pageants). Your children are gorgeous without these things!

Talent

Each contestant is asked to provide a talent. Talent can be anything that your child wants to showcase from singing, to baton twirling, or dancing. The talent portion is Outfit of choice! Participation in the talent portion will be for ages 8 and up. *Please bring a cd if you need music for your talent!

Children 0-7 are only judged on the evening wear portion of the contest.

Parade

The festival parade is Saturday. The Queen from each age group is invited to dress up and wear her crown and sash. You will need to find your own ride and get permission from the vehicle owner to decorate the car. More information will be provided after crowning.

Requirements for Entry

1. Must meet age division requirements by June 1st 2017
2. Participants DO NOT have to be from the city of Morenci
3. Ages 8 and up must perform a talent on stage. The routine should last no more than 3 minutes and contestant must provide their own music if needed.
4. Must be available for practice on Wednesday, June 14th at 6pm.
5. Entry Fee must be paid at the time of registration.
6. If crowned queen participant must agree to come back next year 2018 to crown the new queen.

Awards

The queen and princess in each age division will receive a crown and sash.
